Scope:

This policy applies to all the value added courses offered by St. Joseph College of Teacher Education for Women, Ernakulam

- 1. Admission is open to students of B.Ed and M.Ed Programme
- 2. Maximum intake for the course is 150
- 3. All students should enrol in at least one Value Added course in a year.
- 4. Course fee for the Value Added Course should be remitted at the time of admission.

Evaluation procedure

- 1.At least 80% attendance is required to appear for theory examination.
- 2. Students enrolling for the value added course must complete the tasks given during the course and must also appear for the examination.
- 3. A Value Added Course Certificate will be issued to all those successfully completing the Course.
