




Photo of Teaching Aid Exhibition (Developing Working in Team Skills)





Dealing with student's diversity

Mentees actively participate in initiatives aimed at improving their understanding, attitude, and behavior towards diverse student communities. Orientation talks on **inclusive education**, **visits to special schools**, **rehabilitation centres for the differently abled** help our students to develop empathy and understand the ways of dealing with diverse groups. 


Photo of Orientation On Women Rights By Adv. Shiby Varghese, Senior Advocate At Munsiff's Court, Cherthala




Photo of Webinar on Antinarcotic activities -Horizon 2021
