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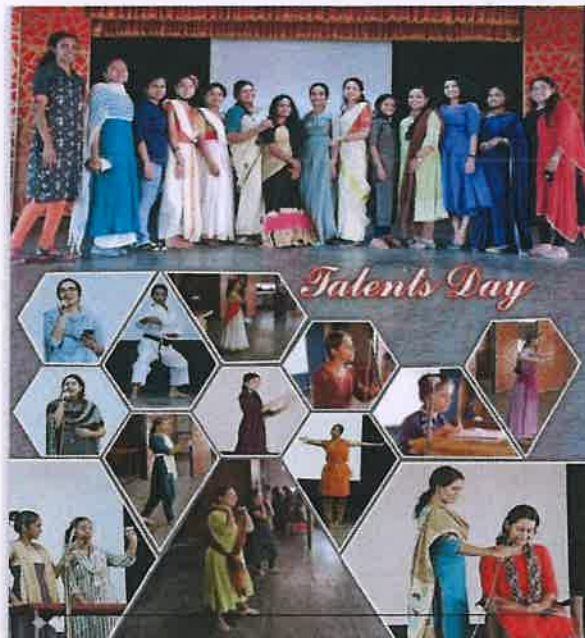


Aroha (2021) community living camp had a duration of 5 days. There were particular themes set down for each day and the activities of each day were based on these themes which included,
